The selected applicant has to report to the Principal for interview on the date fixed and produce the documents called for, accompanied by parent or guardian. The selected students will only be admitted on payment of the first installment of fees. The following documents have to be produced at the time

- 01. Higher Secondary Mark List along with one attested copy of the same
- 02. Transfer Certificate.
- 03. Course and Conduct Certificate from the Head of the institution last
- 04. Three Passport Size Photos with Name and Application Number written on a seperate sheet of paper.

Mark list of the qualifying examination and other certificates once submitted in the College Office will not be returned to the students except in case of discontinuing or completing their studies.

The students are advised to keep in their hands attested copies of these documents. Fees once remitted shall not be refunded.





THE KERALA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT. 1998* (Act 10 of 1998) An Act to Prohibit ragging in educational institutions in the State of Kerala.

Ragging – Meaning: Display of noisy disorderly conduct doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student, teasing, abusing or playing pranks on or causing hurt to any student, asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student is not willingly to do, whoever commits, participates in acts or propagates ragging will be punished.

Punishment: Rigorous Imprisonment (RI) for a period of 2 years with a penalty of Rs. 10,000/- and immediate expulsion from the educational institution without any enguiry and with no provision for joining any other

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the campus. An Anti-Ragging cell is formed in the college to address the
