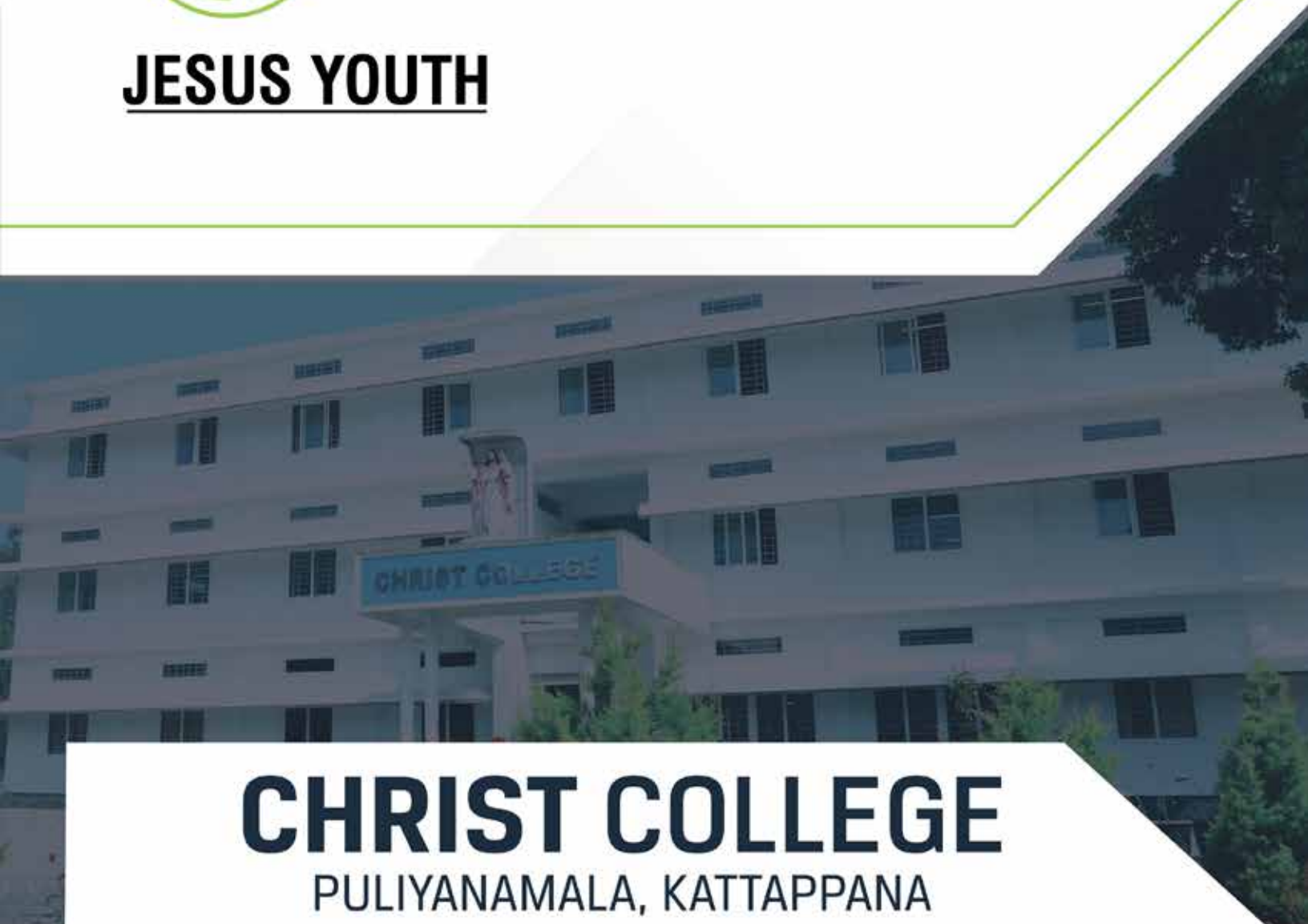




During this year, the fire of the Holy Spirit instilled in our Christiles and they started praying more and so many students get motivated and gathered for the ministry and the prayer service






