ANTI-RAGGING CELL

Anti-Ragging Cell is one of the key component of the Educational Institutions mechanism. As per the guidelines of UGC, under the Act of 1956, which is modified as UGC regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, the establishment of Anti-Ragging cell is compulsory. Ragging should be defined as any action that stops, disrupts, or upsets a student's academic activity. Additionally, any physical abuse, including all variations that cause physical or emotional pain, as well as verbal abuse, is prohibited.

OBJECTIVES:

- The committee will be the supervisory and advisory, in preserving a culture of ragging-free environment in the college campus.
- The cell will be responsible for designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by executing a variety of activities.
- The cell will also employ a variety of methods to educate the students about the concerns with ragging and its subsequent consequences in order to create a disciplined environment.






- maintaining collegiate etiquette.

LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

- Every incident of ragging will be investigated by one of the Anti ragging squads who will go into the details and submit all relevant information to the Principal along with their findings and recommendations.
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Filing of FIR with the police.
- Collective punishment may be imposed where the persons involved are not identified.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- By the Law and Order Agencies:
Over and above the Institute-level action, there will be strong police and legal action. Ragging is a cognizable offence under the law of the land, and the Supreme Court has ruled that the punishment to be meted out has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to

Penal code [IPC], those found guilty of a ragging related offence can be punished with imprisonment or fine or both. The quantum of punishment varies with the gravity of the crime.

The meeting of Anti ragging cell of our college was conducted at 11:00 am on 24 June 2018 in the Principal's office.







Decisions of the meeting.






3. It is resolved to concentrate more on counselling and student mentorship to support students for their overall improvement and success.






