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EXAMINATION REPORT

Exam and evaluation holds a vital role in strengthening the productive output of students as

well as the institution. Innovative evaluation process in higher education system is required to

gauge the knowledge and skills acquired at various levels of the programs. As part of

imparting quality higher education for undergraduate students, Christ College had already

adopted a well-advanced educational service model for integrated academic support.

Evaluation is the essence of examination and examination is always a priority when it comes

to assessment, the college has instituted a wide range of evaluation processes, which runs

parallel to curriculum delivery.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

• Each and every exam taken place in the college is controlled and organized by the

Controller of Examination.

• Each semester consists of two internal exams, one Model Exam and University

Exam. The maximum marks scored for each internal exam is 50 and 80 for Model

Exam.

• A minimum of 85% of attendance is advisable and mandatory for appearing for

Internal and Model Examination.

Both Internal and Model Exams are compulsory and it will be conducted during odd

and even Semesters periodically. Appropriate remedial measures are given to all exam

defaulters.

The external theory Examination of all Semesters shall be conducted by the

University at the end of each Semester. For all courses without practical, total marks

of External Examination is 80 and total marks of Internal evaluation is 20. These

marks are allotted based on certain norms such as Attendance, Internal Exams, Model

Exams, Seminars and Assignments respectively.

- As per the university norms minimum internal mark for each subject is 30% (6 out of 20)
- It is the obligation of every student to score a minimum of 80% of internal marks (16 out of 20) in every subject. This level is highly recommended by the college in order to boost the academic progress of students.
- The evaluations of all components are published which are to be acknowledged by the students. All documents of Internal assessments—are to be kept in the college for a minimum of three years and shall be made available for verification whenever—the University demands. The responsibility of evaluating the Internal assessment is completely vested on the faculty, who is entrusted with handling of the respective subject paper.
- As mentioned in the Report of 2016, our college still continues with the system of analyzing the results department wise. Both University as well as Internal Examinations faculty is always present in the forefront to conduct remedial measures for exam defaulters and also to provide them with a helping hand whenever needed.

EXAMINATION REPORT 2014-2015

The college had taken certain measures of evaluation in the form of internals and model exams for the three existing course programmes namely B Com F&T,B Com CA and BA Economics. The vital fact that should be borne in mind is that the College was temporarily functioning at

Kattappana and hasn't shifted to Puliyanmala which clearly states that the college was functioning well along with its limited facilities, with the cooperation of faculty and students. Under the guidance of our then senior faculty, Mr. Jayasagar C.P,in consultation with College principal Jose J Nedumpara CMI, the college conducted two Internals and one Model Exam for each Semester to improve the educational quality of students. Besides conducting continuous Internal evaluations, the publishing of assessment results, treating University Exams very seriously; the college always took initiative in organizing PTA meetings so as to let the parents track the academic progress of their wards, following the rules of the University.

Remedial Steps taken

Alike the previous years, remedial measures such as answering the question papers of assessments, Viva Voce, PPT presentations were assigned for exam defaulters. A Report Card system, carrying the academic details of individual students, was also issued for the first time during the PTA meeting which was conducted on 26 th September 2015 and the same practice was continued by the Examination Cell.

EXAMINATION REPORT 2019-2020

TIME TABLE

One month before the commencement of Internal Examination, the schedule for the internal assessment containing the dates and time of the internal test and general instructions regarding examination was circulated in the respective classrooms and also published in notice board and in the college website for students perusal.

ATTENDENCE

Affiliated university recommends 75% of attendance is compulsory for writing University Examination. The internal assessment of our college is also carried out as per the regulations and norms of the university. So before the internal examination an attendance report was given to the students with their attendance percentageand inform them about the eligibility to write the examinations. If anyone hadbelow 75% of attendance, those students were directed to write the reason for the shortage of attendance on the reverse side of the attendance report. After getting the signature on the explanation letter from the mentor, Controller of Examination, respective HOD and Fr. Santhosh Chembakanthunkal CMI it can be submitted to Fr. Principal personally on specific time, requesting the permission to write the examination. This procedure helps to make awareness among the students to attend classes regularly to maintain their eligibility to write the examination and for the relevance internal marks.

GUIDELINES

Before the commencement of internal examination, a proper guideline published in the college notice board for students and also faculty members for the smooth functioning of examination. It has helped both the faculty members and students to involve themselves in the examination process more effectively without any confusion.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION DETAILS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

According to the REGULATIONS FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMS UNDER CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM 2017 issued by Mahatma Gandhi University Kottayam two test papers are compulsory in each Semester for each course. The evaluations of all components are to be published and are to be acknowledged by the candidates. All documents of the internal assessment are to be kept in the college for three years. The responsibility of evaluating the internal assessment is vested on the teacher, who teach the course. Christ College strictly follow the instructions without any manipulation. When the syllabus reaches its one third of completion, we conduct first internal examination for every batch which help in the perfect moulding of students for the university examinations.

REMEDIAL STEPS TAKEN FOR ABSENTEES AND LOW SCORERS

From the academic year 2019-20 onwards the college has put forthcertain policies as per the guidance of IQAC that are to be followed by the students who absent themselves from the Internal examinations and minimum marks scorers as decided by the college.

- ➤ The students who have scored less than 60 % marks for individual subjects in the internal / model examination should attempt the question paper 1 time without avoiding the optional questions. They should submit the answers to the concerned teacher and then to the Controller of Examination within the time limit.
- > Students who were absent for the respective internal /model examination should attend the respective question paper twice without avoiding optional questions.

These students must be present for viva voce in front of the teacher concerned.

In the even Semester there is a slight variation in this policy i.e. the absentees should attempt the question paper 3times, students scoring marks below 40% should attempt the question paper 2 times and students scoring marks between 40 % to 60 % should attempt the question paper one time without avoiding optional questions.

PTA MEETING

Soon after the internal examination, results are published and a PTA meeting will be conducted by the college to inform the parents about their wards academic performances. The PTA Meeting conducted regarding the odd Semester internal exams in 2019-20 were on 6th August , 7th August , 9th September for IIIrd, Vth ,Ist Semester respectively. PTA for even Semester conducted only for IVth and VIth Semester students on 7th Feb 2020 and 10th Feb. 2020 respectively. Due to Covid 19 PTA for second Semester were cancelled.

MODEL EXAMINATIONS 2019- 2020

College conduct model examination covering the entire syllabus at the end of each Semester. This helped the students for their time management, enhancing preparedness and building confidence for their final examination. It was scheduled in alternative days. In context of Covid 19 Govt. of Kerala declared holiday for educational institutions on 10th March 2020.

So model examination scheduled for IV & VI Semester from 10th march to13th march were cancelled.

With the help of this software students can submit their assignments, attend MCQ examination and also, they can submit the descriptive type examination.

Attendance

As per the university norms 75% attendance is mandatory for all the students to attend the university examination. Though in the period of 2020-21 academic year due to Covid 19, attendance was not mandatory for the students as per the Government and University norms, Christ College ensured the attendance of all students even in online mode of education and made sure that majority of the students were attending their classes.

Assignment/Seminars

Alike the regular offline working system, in this academic year also Students should submit their assignments through Exam Portal. For each subject, they had to prepare two assignments and submit it to the respective faculty through the exam portal using their ID and password. Seminars were also given prior importance and made sure that it was conducted by students using PPT and other aids in online mode.

Guidelines

Before the commencement of MCQ and Internal examination, proper guidelines were published in the respective class WhatsApp groups for students and also faculty members and an online meeting was held for the smooth conduct of the examination. It had helped both the Faculty and students to involve themselves in the examination process more effectively without any confusion.

MCQ Examinations

At the time of pandemic covid-19 situation entire education system were transferred to online mode in all over the country. At that time Christ College also conducted regular online classes and evaluation system very effectively. For this purpose college introduced a new pattern of examination system i.e., Multiple Choice examination through the exam portal. Along with this both faculty and Institution appraisal were also conducted. MCQ examination is always conducted one day prior to the internal examination of each subject. This has helped the students to gauge their academic progress graph and to imbibe more textual knowledge thereby preparing well for the upcoming examination and other competitive examinations. The duration of MCQ examination is 45 minutes and it includes 50 Objective type questions. As the method has paved for academic progress among students, college has decided to move with the same exam pattern.

Module Test/ Internal Examination

As part of the Internal Assessment, Christ college introduced a new evaluation system — Module Test- to ensure the students progression in studies during the lock down period. In this mode of examination question papers were given through online platform like WhatsApp, Google Classroom, Gmail etc. Gradually the institution adopted a new feature in the Exam Portal i.e., Pen-paper examination to conduct descriptive examinations. In this mode students, downloaded the question paper on time and they uploaded their answer scripts through the exam portal.

The same follow ups were made through online mode examination too.

In online teaching -learning period too, the examinations were conducted in online, due to network issues some students could not attend the examinations and they were directed to attend Viva Voce at the end of the Semester and the deserving internal marks were awarded to them.

PTA Meeting

In the academic year 2020-21 virtual parents meetings were conducted in the month of May, October, and November to update the parents about the online classes and different mode of examinations like MCQ and Module Test conducted by the institution for the academic progress of the students, even though they are staying at home due to lockdown. The main objective of the meeting was to create a common platform, where teachers and parents come together to discuss student's performance and discuss the ways to enrich their learning experience. Parents attended the meeting seriously and was introduced to the new strategies adapted by the institution for the students. Parents whole heartedly expressed their gratitude towards the college management and faculty members for their dedicated services and effort during the online mode of education. During the parents meeting session, Principal had even conveyed the message clearly to parents that once the covid rate lowers and situation resumes back to natural, the college will surely be continuing as usual with students and faculty.

University Examinations

According to the University announcements college conducted University Examinations in a very efficient manner and strictly followed Covid 19 Protocol. EXAMINATION REPORT 2021-22

University Rank:

The college has taken all studious effort keeping in mind the golden achievements scored by our students during the academic year 2019-20 and has motivated both faculty and students to be focused reminding them that they have a goal to succeed in the following days too. The result of this relentless effort reflected in the result of the academic year 2020-21 also, our student Ashly Devasia of Travel and Tourism(2018-21 batch) has made us proud by securing 4th rank in the University examination.

The examination cell, chaired by the guidance of the Controller of Examination Mrs. Anithamol C S, in consultation with Principal Rev. Dr. Alex Louis CMI, executed the internal evaluation process during the academic year 2021–22 in accordance with the COVID 19 protocol in a very prolific manner. Our college is still executing its path of assessments in both online and offline mode. The situation itself demanded a widening and supplementing of more faculty into the Exam Cell.

Exam cell

Under the supervision of the Controller of Examination, Mrs. Anithamol C S, our examination cell was widened with three more additional faculty namely: Mr. Jogi Joseph, Mr. Amal Jose, and Mrs. Thushara T K who were all entrusted with the charge of the internal examination, assignment section and external examination respectively.

Attendance

Due to COVID-19, attendance was initially not compulsory. However, in 2022, this policy was altered to mandate attendance, and since it was too challenging to maintain attendance on a voluntary basis, the institution implemented a policy requiring 85% attendance in order to attend the internal exam. Students were always alerted of their eligibility to write the internal examination by providing an attendance report before the commencement of each internal examination. This procedure has helped the students to understand the relevance of maintaining adequate attendance.

DETAILS OF INTERNAL EXAMINATION AND MCQ EXAMINATIONS IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

M.G University always prescribes two internal examinations for each Semester. The institution conducts an internal examination after completion of one third of the syllabus and a model examination at the completion of each semester. The responsibility of preparing question papers and assessing answer sheets is assigned to the respective faculty. After evaluation, the answer scripts are handed to the students for verification and it is collected back by the respective faculty and submitted to the controller of examination for the preparation of progress report. Internal assessment-related documents are maintained in the college for future reference until an enrolled batch leaves after their course of study. The Online portal is followed up with needed updations and MCQ practice is still continued.
