Introduction

The administration of the college always ensures that all of its staff and students are in a safe and happy environment. The college has established a "Grievance Redressal Committee" in 2016 to investigate the nature and scope of complaints in accordance with the UGC Regulation for handling student or parent complaints in the college. The committee has the authority to recommend the final action to be taken at the institutional level to address the issue. In order to preserve a positive learning environment in the institute, the college Grievance Cell tries to foster a responsive and accountable attitude among all stakeholders. The committee is comprised of the principal as well as two senior faculty members.

Objectives

Students need consistent mental growth in addition to physical growth. To guarantee that no student experiences bias and inequity, a healthy environment is well maintained in the institution. Considering these reasons, the cell takes special attention to address the issues experienced by students. The cell makes it easier for students to communicate and have their genuine grievances and concerns about any kind of academic, administrative, disciplinary, and personal problems addressed freely and frankly without any fear of victimization.

Procedure:

To ensure effective solutions to the student grievances with an impartial and fair approach, they are free to lodge their complaints in mainly two ways, both online and offline. The online "message to principal" option allows for completely confidential communication between the complainant and the head of the institution without the involvement of any mediators. Christities.com is also an online portal where students can lodge their complaints to the officials. The complaint is then subsequently sent to the grievance cell, which will assess the matter, take appropriate action in accordance with management policy, and reach the complainant with practical solutions. As an offline method, students can get in touch with the batch coordinators directly for their problems and this will be brought to the HOD's notice and then forwarded to the grievance cell. Through discussions with the officials of grievance cell, a feasible solution is taken and communicated to the petitioner. The complaints will be handled with maximum privacy and try to keep the aggrieved party in the safest zone always. So far only minor complaints were reported and prompt actions were taken by the committee without hurting the feelings of anybody. Maximum confidentiality has been ensured in dealing with the grievances of the students.

Implementation of the guidelines

In pursuance to the directions of the Hon. Supreme Court and the UGC nortification on Regulation on Curbing the Menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, as Christ College has taken the following preventive measures to eliminate the scourge of ragging among the students to provide them congenial environment to learn and develop both mentally and physically.

Basic Measures

- Conducted frequent student mentorship and counselling sessions in order to improve their social and personal lives.
- The officials of the cell conducted surprise inspection in canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets etc. to monitor anti-social elements in the campus.

Creative Dissemination of the idea of ragging-free campus

- Organized awareness programs on anti-ragging for second- and final students before first-year class begins.
- The institution conducted seminars and workshops regarding cyber and sexual crimes.
- Conducted many online awareness program based on anti-social elements in order to make young minds healthier during these pandemic period.

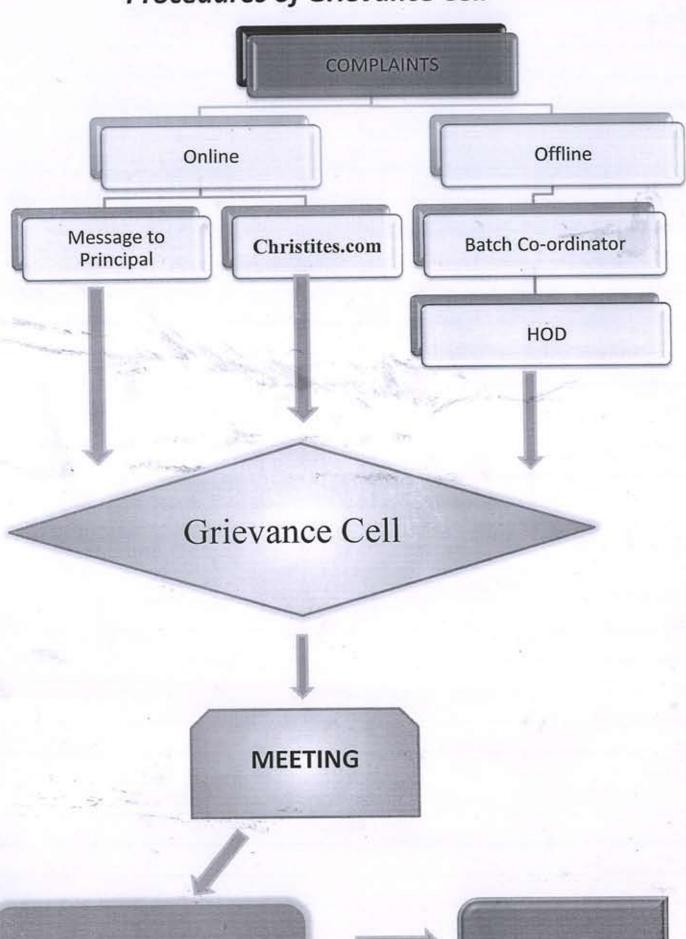
